I list below in detail the colour scheme for St Paul's and would respectfully ask that you follow these guidelines when purchasing school wear.

Black, grey or navy blue school trousers, skirts or pinafores

Sky blue shirt or polo shirt

Striped clip on tie (optional - available through school)

Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan

Navy blue fleeces (if worn in school)

School shorts in grey or navy blue

Blue checked summer dresses

Plain white socks or navy blue or grey tights

Black flat school shoes or school sandals. NO TRAINERS

Girls with long hair should wear it tied back. Nail varnish should not be worn in school.

Every child should have a full PE kit in school at the beginning of each term and take it home to wash every half term. Unless children are able to remove their own earrings for PE/games then none should be worn during the school day. No jewellery is allowed to be worn for PE/games.
