## Questions and Answers!

Which of St Paul's children can come to Breakfast Club?	Any child from Nursery class up to Year 6. Please talk to us if your child has any food allergies.
When is Breakfast Club open?	Every day of term, with few exceptions, which are notified to parents/children well in advance. Opening time is 8.00am but children can arrive anytime between 8am and 8.35am. Children come in through the main school entrance. PLEASE REMEMBER TO SIGN YOUR CHILD INTO BREAKFAST ON ARRIVAL
Do I have to let you know when my child will be coming?	No. We have a daily register and your child can come as often or as little each week as they wish.
Is there a joining up fee?	No, children pay £1 each day for up to 3 items of their choice. <b>Payment should be made via ParentPay.</b> During year 6 SATS week we offer all Year 6 children a free breakfast.
Can I stay with my child?	Children will be greeted on arrival by school staff. Breakfast Club staff are Mrs Hathaway, Mrs Fernandez, Miss Reeves and Mrs Nairn - they are all familiar faces in school as they have other roles here too, and this will help your child to settle.

What happens when my child has finished eating?	There are games and activities set up for Breakfast Club children each morning. We also encourage the children to enter competitions that we are notified of through school, ie Christmas card competition for school milk suppliers and road safety campaign posters. The children leave the hall at their allocated time and go straight to class for morning registration. A member of staff will take the Reception children safely over to their classroom. At no time do children from Breakfast Club go out onto the playground in the morning.
What do the children think about Breakfast Club?	We have regular meetings and surveys to make sure that the children get what they want from Breakfast Club. They enjoy the healthy foods on offer and the calm, friendly environment. Best of all they realise that if they attend Breakfast Club they are guaranteed to be on time for school!
